Dear Sherrif Trochesset:

Dickinson ISD is responsible for the safety of 12,577 students in Galveston County. During the 88<sup>th</sup> Legislative Session, HB 3 was passed, and it requires armed security at all campuses. Unfortunately, the insubstantial increase by legislators to our district safety allotment is insufficient to pay for existing safety expenditures and seven additional deputies and vehicles. While school marshals and guardians are recommended options, they are not the direction DISD wants to pursue to meet the HB 3 requirements. We have had a successful partnership with the Galveston County Sheriff's Department for over a decade, and our goal is to maintain continuity and consistency. At our August 31, 2023 Board of Trustees Meeting, a Resolution to Declare a Good Cause Exception from HB 3 was approved. We have added local funds to our 2023-2024 operating budget for four additional Galveston County School Liaison Officers, and we plan to rotate them between the campuses that are currently without armed security (six elementary campuses and Dickinson Continuation Center).

I cannot imagine Dickinson ISD without the support of our Galveston County officers, and I am writing today to request consideration for purchasing surplus vehicles for these four Student Liaison Officers to use. Officers assigned to our elementary campuses (Grades PreK-3) will not be making arrests or transporting students to the Galveston County jail. The purchase of Galveston County surplus law enforcement vehicles would allow us to add the deputies and provide them with a vehicle so that we fulfill our HB 3 Good Cause Exception Plan and move towards compliance with the new state law. This would create safer environments on campus for students, parents, and employees all located in Galveston County.

We greatly appreciate your support in our efforts to provide for the public safety of Dickinson ISD. Your partnership and support are greatly appreciated, and it has made a positive impact on our district and community.

Please contact me or Robert Cobb, DISD Assistant Superintendent, if you need additional information or if we need to pursue this request for surplus vehicles with someone else in Galveston County Government. Thank you for your consideration of this request, and I look forward to hearing from you soon.
