FY 2025 Statewide Automated Victim Notification Service Grant Award

### **BACKGROUND**

In February 2004, Galveston County Commissioners Court was one of the first in Texas to authorize participation in the VINE Program (Victim Information and Notification Every day). Since that time, thousands of victims in Galveston County have registered for this free service to learn the status and court proceedings scheduled for offenders via telephone, text, or email notifications.

Galveston County's participation in the VINE Program is made possible through a grant from the Texas Attorney General's Office via the Statewide Automated Victim Notification Service (SAVNS) Grant Program.
