



**Motor Vehicle Crime Prevention Authority
2026 Galveston County Resolution
SB 224 Catalytic Converter Grant Program**

WHEREAS, under the provisions of the Texas Transportation Code Chapter 1006 and Texas Administrative Code Title 43; Part 3; Chapter 57, entities are eligible to receive grants from the Motor Vehicle Crime Prevention Authority to provide financial support to law enforcement task forces and agencies for economic motor vehicle theft, including catalytic converter theft; and

WHEREAS, this grant program will assist this jurisdiction to combat catalytic converter theft; and

WHEREAS, Galveston County has agreed that in the event of loss or misuse of the grant funds, Galveston County assures that the grant funds will be returned in full to the Motor Vehicle Crime Prevention Authority.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED and ordered that County Judge Mark Henry, is designated as the Authorized Official to apply for, accept, decline, modify, or cancel the grant application for the Motor Vehicle Crime Prevention Authority Grant Program and all other necessary documents to accept said grant; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Captain Kelcie Miller, is designated as the Program Director and County Auditor Sergio Cruz, is designated as the Financial Officer for this grant.


