

Arcosa, Inc. operates one lightweight aggregate plant in the state of Texas; the plant is in Streetman, TX (Navarro County) and it produces *expanded shale* lightweight aggregates. This expanded shale plant is the only one within the state of Texas; therefore, we are a sole producer and single source of this material *within Texas*. This material is bid statewide on TxDOT, City and County projects / purchase agreements as an alternate to stone and gravel per the TxDOT Item 302 Specification. We currently supply approximately 20% of the surface treatment aggregate used in the eastern half of Texas on TxDOT district maintenance and construction seal coats.

Our Streetman expanded shale has the highest polish value of any aggregate that is rated and monitored by the Texas Department of Transportation Bituminous Rated Source Quality Catalog of aggregates for surface treatments. What that means is that the skid value of this material is the best in the State of Texas throughout the life of the material. Additionally, because the material is half the weight of stone and gravel there is virtually no windshield or vehicle damage realized during construction.

Please keep in mind that when bidding lightweight aggregate the unit of bid/payment must be by the <u>CUBIC YARD</u> rather than the ton. Lightweight Aggregate weighs approximately 53 lbs. per cubic foot (1430 lbs. per cubic yard) where stone and gravel can weigh as much as 110 lbs. per cubic foot (3000 lbs. per cubic yard). When comparing the two, you must know the unit weight of a particular stone or gravel. Multiply that unit weight by 27, which will give you the lbs. per cubic yard of a material. Then divide the lbs. per cubic yard by 2,000 (a ton in lbs.) to get the conversion factor. Once a conversion factor is determined, multiply the cost per ton of a particular stone or gravel by the conversion factor to get the price per cubic yard. Then you can compare the cost equally.

The Galveston County Purchasing Department utilizes Bonfire Interactive to distribute and receive bids and proposals in an electronic format via an online portal. Potential Bidders must register through the online portal to participate electronically. "Walk-in" or "mailed-in" proposal submittals are still allowed, however, Bidders are strongly encouraged to submit their proposals online via Galveston County's e-Procurement Portal located at https://galvestoncountytx.bonfirehub.com/.

The County, at its sole discretion, may not issue a response to an RFI submittal. Bidders should not rely on any oral or written representations, statements, or explanations, other than those made in this solicitation or in any written addendum to this solicitation. Where there appears to be conflict between the solicitation and any issued addenda, the last addendum issued will prevail.

The Galveston County Commissioners' Court, and/or authorized designees will be responsible for negotiating with the successful Vendor the scope of work, the standards of performance, the specific technology provided, and the support services required for the proposed projects. All contractual amendments will be processed in accordance with Galveston County Purchasing Policies. Amendments will also be brought to Galveston County Commissioners Court for approval as deemed necessary. The approval process serves to ensure the project technology and/or service is within the scope of the resultant contract, and that pricing meets the agreed-upon pricing methodology as specified in the contract, and that funds are available.

#### K. INSURANCE

Bidder must submit, with its response, a current certificate of insurance evidencing coverage in the amounts specified below or greater. In lieu of submitting a certificate of insurance, Bidders may submit a notarized statement from an insurance company authorized to conduct business in the State of Texas guaranteeing that Bidder has such insurance. Provided, however, that successful Bidder(s) shall be required to provide a current certificate of insurance to the Galveston County Purchasing Agent's Office before Bidder commences any work hereunder. Insurance shall be placed with insurers having an A.M. Best's rating of no less than A. Such insurance must be issued by a casualty company authorized to do business in the State of Texas and in standard form approved by the Board of Insurance Commissioners of the State of Texas, with coverage provisions ensuring the public from loss or damage that may arise to any person or property by reason of services rendered by Contractor.

Galveston County shall be listed as an additional insured on each policy and all certificates of insurance and Contractor shall provide Galveston County with no less than thirty (30) calendar days prior notice of any changes to the policy during the contractual period.

Certificates of Insurance, fully executed by a licensed representative of the insurance company written or countersigned by an authorized Texas state agency, shall be filed with the County Purchasing Agent within ten (10) calendar days of the execution of this Agreement as written proof of such insurance and further provided that Contractor shall not commence work under this Agreement until Contractor has obtained all insurance required herein, provided written proof as required herein, and received written notice to proceed issued from the County Purchasing Agent. Failure to provide such evidence of insurance within the ten (10) calendar day period shall constitute an event of default. Workers' Compensation Insurance. Bidder shall carry in full force Workers' Compensation Insurance Policy(ies), if there is more than one employee, for all its employees, including but not limited to full time, part time, and emergency employees employed by the Contractor.

Commercial General Liability. Bidder shall carry in full force commercial general liability insurance with a limit of not less than \$1,000,000 each occurrence and \$2,000,000 in the aggregate. The Policy shall, minimally, cover liability for bodily injury, personal injury, and property damage.

Business Automobile Liability. Bidder shall carry in full force business automobile liability coverage with a combined bodily injury/property damage limit of not less than \$1,000,000 each accident. The policy shall cover liability arising from the operation of licensed vehicles by policyholder.

Subrogation Waiver. Contractor and Contractor's insurance carrier shall waive any and all rights to subrogation against Galveston County in regard to any suit or claim arising out of personal injury or property damage resulting from Contractor's performance under this Agreement.

### L. REQUIREMENTS OF INVITATION TO BID

Bidder shall provide one (1) original and three (3) hard copies of its response to the Purchasing Agent on or before the submission deadline specified herein. Font size is limited to no smaller than font size 11, except that organization charts, other graphics, and footers may be as small as font size 9.

## M. MATERIAL DESCRIPTION/SPECIFICATIONS

The following specifications are the minimum acceptable specifications for lightweight aggregate material used by Galveston County Road & Bridge Department.

Please reference Texas Department of Transportation, Item 302, Aggregates for Surface Treatments TYPE L Grade 3, 4, and 5.

#### N. QUANTITIES

Submitted bid pricing shall be based on anticipated requirements of 4,000 cubic yards, however, the County does not guarantee any minimum or maximum purchase and will pay only for the material ordered and delivered in Galveston County at the designated locations.

### O. MEASUREMENTS AND PAYMENTS

Measurement shall be by the cubic yard at the requested designation points. Payment will be made on this basis, per cubic yard, including freight and delivery charges. Galveston County is tax-exempt and therefore no taxes, license fees, etc. shall be added to bid prices. Galveston County reserves the right to order more or less of this product.

#### P. POINTS OF DELIVERY

The requested materials shall be furnished and delivered to the specified locations, satisfactory to the Galveston County Road Administrator, at the following Galveston County locations:

- Santa Fe, Texas
- · Dickinson, Texas
- Crystal Beach, Texas
- San Leon, Texas

### O. ORDERING AND PURCHASING

The County expects to order lightweight aggregate material at the rate of 500 cubic yards per stated location. However, there may be times when more of the product will be ordered, where possible, to reduce freight charges.

#### R. AWARDED PRICES

Any unit prices submitted by the Bidder shall include all costs to the County, including the material, delivery, current freight rate, state tax, or any other cost.

Award prices include all royalties and costs arising from patents, trademarks, and copyrights in any way involved in the work. Whenever the Awardee is required or desires to use any design, device, material or process covered by letters of patent or copyright, the Awardee shall indemnify and save harmless the County, its officers, agents and employees from any and all claims for infringement by reason of the use of any such patented design, tool, material, equipment, or process, to be performed under the contract, and shall indemnify the County its officers, agents, and employees for any costs, expenses and damages which may be incurred by reason of any infringement at any time during the prosecution or after the completion of the work.

#### S. INVOICES:

Invoices must be itemized indicating all materials and supplies used. Invoices must be submitted to:

Contractor shall not perform any work or release any supplies and/or equipment to any authorized representative of the County of Galveston unless a valid purchase order number issued by the office of the Galveston County Purchasing Agent accompanies the order or if vendor can comply with the provision as stated in the General Provisions, page 3, item 11, Procurement Card Program.

Payment for any items issued without prior receipt of a valid purchase order number may become the sole responsibility of the successful contractor.
