I had a conversation with our MVCPA Auditors this morning to try to correct the inventory report to remove the old LPR, inventory item 604 and whether/how to add the new Tahoe to the inventory report. The process to remove it from the inventory involves notifying the state of the damage, which Lt Barrow did do as you can see from the email thread and attached accident report, which I received from Dan Price. But we did not follow through on the financial side of things, and so we need to proceed with the proper way to dispose.

If I understood everything correctly, due to the old LPR vehicle being paid for partially with grant funds the county actually owes money back on this. The amount would be half of the insurance payment, or value of the vehicle as it was prior to the accident if there was no insurance payment. The email thread below indicates there would be no insurance payout on this due to the County being self-insured and the accident being at fault. So the state *should* have been paid half the pre-accident value by the end of the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter of FY 2024. We checked KBB and JD Vance for the value while on the phone and it showed \$16,500 which means the County technically owes the state \$8,250 to settle this and remove it from the inventory. However, because half the

cost was paid with Program Income, Mr. Price said the \$8,250 could be deposited (or journal entried) to our Program Income account to settle this as well. But I do think it would involve re-opening the Q4 Expenditure Report to correct.

Since the County paid for the replacement vehicle, it does *not* need to be listed on the Inventory Report at all and would remain a County asset.

Dan, please feel free to correct my mistakes or explain it better if I have it wrong.
