DR-4798 – Hurricane Beryl

BACKGROUND

Hurricane Beryl hit Galveston County between July 5^{th} – 9^{th} , 2024 and caused damages and a need for emergency protective measurers throughout the county. Commissioners Court ratified the submission of the FEMA Request for Public Assistance on July 22,2024.

In December, staff submitted a full Damage Inventory and has been working with FEMA to organize those damages into eleven (11) logical projects.

SUMMARY

FEMA's current process will require sub-applicants like the County, to provide descriptions of the damages as well as documented expense records before a project is awarded. With this process in mind, staff is requesting permission to open individual project grant accounts to allow for separation and documentation of expenses for each proposed FEMA project. Although, staff anticipates FEMA eligibility, at this time, the projects are proposed and there is not an available guarantee FEMA will reimburse for the expenses, which would leave the General Fund to pay for repairs.
