#### **BACKGROUND**

The Office of the Governor – Criminal Justice Division administers the Project Safe Neighborhoods Grant Program for projects that are designed to create and foster safer neighborhoods through a sustained reduction in violent crime, including, but not limited to, addressing criminal gangs and felonious possession and use of firearms.

#### **SUMMARY**

The Galveston County Sheriff's has identified the Bacliff/San Leon area as high gang and drug-related violent crime areas. This grant project will provide overtime hours for Sheriff's Deputies to operate specific patrol activities in problem-areas.

Patrol teams will include two to three deputies who operate four-hour targeted patrols up to twice a week for one year.
