PROTECT Grant Application - us Department of Transportation

BACKGROUND

The 2024-2026 Promoting Resilient Operations for Transformative, Efficient, and Cost-Saving Transportation (PROTECT) grant program from the US Department of Transportation provides funding to strengthen surface transportation to be more resilient to natural hazards, including climate change, sea level rise, heat waves, flooding, extreme weather events, and other natural disasters through support of planning activities, resilience improvements, community resilience and evacuation routes, and at-risk coastal infrastructure.

There are four types of PROTECT grants:

- 1. Planning
- 2. Resilience Improvement
- 3. Community Resilience and Evacuation Route
- 4. At-Risk Coastal Infrastructure

SUMMARY

A project to plan, design and replace the San Luis Pass bridge qualifies for all four types of PROTECT grants. Application for all 4 is recommended to increase the likelihood of award. Planning grants may be fully funded by the grant with the remaining grant types requiring a local match. The PROTECT grant program's local match requirement is an 80/20 funding split with 80% being provided by the federal government and 20% funded through local funds. The bridge replacement project has a total estimated cost of \$104,600,000. Based on these requirements the proposed funding split is as follows; Federal grant funded split \$83,880,000, local Galveston County match \$20,720,000.

The San Luis Pass Bridge is a 1.3-mile toll bridge connecting Follett's Island to the south in Brazoria County with Galveston Island to the north in Galveston County. San Luis pass bridge serves as an important connection in the Bluewater Highway – San Luis Pass Road corridor for local traffic, tourism and hurricane evacuation. Without the bridge traffic would be forced to detour to the mainland to reach the other side of the bridge, a significant increase in distance

and travel time. The bridge was completed in 1966 as the replacement to a causeway destroyed by Hurricane Carla in 1961. During the last bridge inspection in December 2023 the superstructure was rated in poor condition. Given the age of the structure, the superstructure rating of poor and the likelihood of future coastal storms impacting the area, a replacement modern bridge is needed.
