Whereas, by Order on June 29, 2021, the Commissioners Court declared a local state of disaster based on threats to public health of individuals unlawfully crossing the Texas-Mexico border; and

Whereas, the local state of disaster established the Galveston County Border Security Response Team, authorized to assist other counties on or near the border that also experienced a declared state of disaster that requested assistance to uphold the sovereignty and territorial integrity of the State and mitigate public health effects in this county.

Now, Therefore, it is hereby ORDERED, pursuant to the authority granted in Chapter 418 Texas Government Code that:

- 1.) the Declaration of Local State of Disaster that was issued on June 29, 2021, is hereby **TERMINATED**; and
- 2.) this ORDER is and shall be effective immediately on and from its issuance; and
- 3.) this **ORDER** shall be given prompt and general publicity and shall be filed promptly with the County Clerk; and
- 4.) the County Judge of Galveston County, Texas, is authorized to execute this ORDER.
