A. PURPOSE

Galveston County is seeking a vendor that can provide professional services for the removal and installation of vinyl graphics on Galveston County law enforcement vehicles.

Each Bidder shall be responsible to monitor the County website for new or revised solicitation information. The County shall not be bound by any verbal information, nor shall it be bound by any written information that is not either contained within the solicitation or formally issued as an addendum by the Purchasing Agent.

The Galveston County Commissioners' Court, and/or authorized designees will be responsible for negotiating with the successful Vendor the scope of work, the standards of performance, the specific technology provided, and the support services required for the proposed projects. All contractual amendments will be processed in accordance with Galveston County Purchasing Policies. Amendments will also be brought to Galveston County Commissioners Court for approval as deemed necessary. The approval process serves to ensure the project technology and/or service is within the scope of the resultant contract, that pricing meets the agreed-upon pricing methodology as specified in the contract, and that funds are available.

K. REQUIREMENTS OF INVITATION TO BID

If bids are "walk-in" bids, the Bidder shall provide one (1) unbound single-sided original and two (2) single-sided hard copies of its response, to the Purchasing Agent on or before the submission deadline specified herein. Font size no smaller than font size 11. Except that organizational charts, other graphics, and footers may be as small as font size 9.

Bidders shall clearly indicate which project or projects are being submitted for consideration in their cover letter.

L. INSURANCE

Bidder must submit, with its response, a current certificate of insurance evidencing coverage in the amounts specified below or greater. In lieu of submitting a certificate of insurance, Bidders may submit a notarized statement from an insurance company authorized to conduct business in the State of Texas guaranteeing that Bidder has such insurance. Provided however, that successful Bidder(s) shall be required to provide a current certificate of insurance to the Galveston County Purchasing Agent's Office before Bidder commences any work hereunder. **Insurance shall be placed with insurers having an A.M. Best's rating of no less than A.** Such insurance must be issued by a casualty company authorized to do business in the State of Texas and in standard form approved by the Board of Insurance Commissioners of the State of Texas, with coverage provisions ensuring the public from loss or damage that may arise to any person or property by reason of services rendered by Contractor.

Galveston County shall be listed as an additional insured on each policy and all certificates of insurance and Contractor shall provide Galveston County with no less than thirty (30) calendar days prior notice of any changes to the policy during the contractual period.

Certificates of Insurance, fully executed by a licensed representative of the insurance company written or countersigned by an authorized Texas state agency, shall be filed with the County Purchasing Agent within ten (10) calendar days of the execution of this Agreement as written proof of such insurance and further provided that Contractor shall not commence work under this Agreement until Contractor has obtained all insurance required herein, provided written proof as required herein, and received written notice to proceed issued from the County Purchasing Agent. **Failure to provide such evidence of insurance within the ten (10) calendar day period shall constitute an event of default.**

Workers' Compensation Insurance. Bidder shall carry in full force Workers' Compensation Insurance Policy(ies), if there is more than one employee, for all its employees, including but not limited to full time, part time, and emergency employees employed by the Contractor.

Commercial General Liability. Bidder shall carry in full force commercial general liability insurance with a limit of not less than \$1,000,000 each occurrence and \$2,000,000 in the aggregate. The Policy shall, minimally, cover liability for bodily injury, personal injury, and property damage.

Business Automobile Liability. Bidder shall carry in full force business automobile liability coverage with a combined bodily injury/property damage limit of not less than \$1,000,000 each accident. The policy shall cover liability arising from the operation of licensed vehicles by policyholder.

Subrogation Waiver. Contractor and Contractor's insurance carrier shall waive any and all rights to subrogation against Galveston County in regard to any suit or claim arising out of personal injury or property damage resulting from Contractor's performance under this Agreement.

M. TAXES

Galveston County is tax exempt and does not pay state or federal taxes. Invoices shall not include any taxes. Vendor shall furnish any exemption certificates needed for Government records.

N. SCOPE OF WORK/SPECIFICATIONS

1. General Requirements

- a) This contract will be on an as-needed, as-ordered basis, with an indefinite quantity and no minimum or maximum guarantees.

The Galveston County Road and Bridge Department intends to order decals just for our warehouse stock and also place orders to install new decals and/or remove and replace decals.

b) Services to remove/replace and install new decals:

- 1) When ordered, the contractor shall provide all labor, supervision, equipment, tools, materials, and incidentals necessary to install new decals or remove and replace decals in accordance with the decal material manufacturer's requirements.
- 2) Except for the price of the actual decals, the pricing bid for services shall be all inclusive, including travel expenses
- 3) The Contractor shall be required to perform services within 10 business days after receipt of order.

- 4) The bidder shall have extensive experience with installing decals on vehicles and all work must be deemed acceptable by the County
 - 5) Unacceptable services will result in contract termination.
 - 6) All items must be set in place, ready for use. All crating, packaging and debris and debris must be removed from the premises at the Contractor's expense. In addition, the contractor must ensure that all debris is properly and securely disposed of so that the general public cannot acquire used decals.
 - 7) The contractor shall be required to coordinate all services with the Contract Administrator(s) assigned to this contract.
- c) **Delivery:** The contractor shall maintain adequate stock in order to ship product in full within ten (10) calendar days after receipt of order. Orders not meeting original or approved changed delivery date may be cancelled at no cost to the department and may be purchased from alternative sources.
- d) **Shipping Method:** Unit price shall be FOB Destination, freight included in bid specs.
- e) **Bid Samples:** If requested by the County, the bidder shall submit bid samples for each product offered within five (5) calendar days. Failure on the part of the bidder to provide such samples as requested may result in the bid to be considered nonresponsive. Bid samples shall be an exact and true representation of the actual product offered. Bid samples shall be provided at no cost to the County.
- f) **Substitutions:** No substitution may be allowed without the written consent of the County's authorized representative prior to shipment and/or contract modification.
- g) **Packaging:** Each decal kit that is purchased for warehouse stock shall be packaged in a clear plastic sleeve or wrapped as an individual kit, ready for installation. The bidder must ensure packaging will not cause damage or creasing to the decals during transport or storage.
- h) No over or under runs will be accepted.
- i) Any decals that do not comply with the specifications, have defects or misprints, will not be accepted. The Contractor shall accept returns and provided a full credit for any decals ordered.
- j) **Initial "rebrand" project:** Approximately 15 days after award, the Contractor shall be required to provide services to remove and replace decals on approximately two hundred (200) model year 2016-newer Patrol Vehicles; Ford Explorer Patrol SUVs, Ford F150 PPVs, Chevy 1500 PPVs, Chevy 2500, Ford F250 & F350, Chevrolet Tahoe PPVs, and Transit Vans.

The County would like all vehicles completed by June 30, 2025. The Contractor must provide these services at the Galveston County Fleet Department. The County will not bring the brand project vehicles to the Contractor's locations unless specified at a later time.

This project must be coordinated between the Contractor and the Galveston County Road and Bridge Department.

The County reserves the right to make changes to this contract and add and delete items.

Ownership of Artwork and Specifications: The County of Galveston shall have full rights to all artwork created under this contract. Reproduceable artwork and specifications shall be provided to the County within 10 days of request.

2. Technical Specifications

- a) **Material:** All decal material must be produced from white reflective 3M 8518 vinyl or equivalent. Alternates or substitutions must be noted on the bid submission.
- b) **Installation:** Contractor must ensure that decals align correctly. Should these issues occur, replacement decals shall be furnished and installed at the contractor's expense.
- c) **Copy:** Contractor shall be responsible for all typesetting, paste-up, and layout.
- d) **Rebrand Project for 2016 or New Patrol Vehicles (approx. 200 vehicles):**
 - 1) Line 1: Remove and replace existing decal stripe and graphics on all sides.
Replace with new "Galveston County Sheriff" and Galveston County Constable PCT 1 and PCT 2 decal and graphics.
- e) **Pricing**
 - 1) Pricing shall be quoted per square foot of RTA (Ready to Apply) reflective vinyl installation and an hourly rate for removal of existing graphics.

O. INVOICES

Payment for any items issued without prior receipt of a valid purchase order number may become the sole responsibility of the successful contractor.
