Subject: FY 2026 – TPWD – Texas Range Program (Planning Grant) – Galveston County Parks Department

Background

Galveston County has a strong history of enhancing and maintaining local parks through strategic use of Texas Parks and Wildlife Department (TPWD) grant funding. These investments have allowed the County Parks Department to expand recreational opportunities, improve accessibility, and modernize park amenities in a way that would not be possible through local funding alone. Each TPWD-funded project is guided by the County's mission to serve Galveston County residents by providing safe, inclusive, and high-quality outdoor spaces that promote health, community engagement, and quality of life for citizens of all ages.

Summary

The FY 2026 Texas Range Program (Planning Grant) – Will allow the county to complete environmental review and design services for a new Clay Shooting Range located within Jack Brook's Park. There will be additional future funding to also cover the construction phase.
