In response to the request to repair the existing bulkhead structure, Lucas Construction Company, Inc. proposes to provide labor, materials, equipment, layout, supervision, and insurance to make the following changes to the current contract:

-Repair existing 65 LF of bulkhead by replacing all driven pilings, horizontal members, and vertical members with structural wood materials. Bulkhead layout to remain the same as existing, including wood decking walkway. All necessary demolition is included.
