CONTRACT TO PROVIDE PROSECUTOR SERVICES TO GALVESTON COUNTY CRIMINAL DISTRICT ATTORNEY

- 1. Parties to this agreement are Jack Roady, Criminal District Attorney of Galveston County, and J.T. "Ted" Mora, Jr.
- 2. The term of this agreement begins on the date agreed/signed and terminates on September 30, 2026, and may be cancelled by any of the parties conditioned upon one (1) week written notice to the other parties.
- 3. Criminal District Attorney Jack Roady agrees to appoint J.T. "Ted" Mora, Jr. to the position of Special Prosecutor to represent the State in all proceedings in all of the Justice of the Peace Courts in Galveston County, Texas, on an as-needed basis.
- 4. J.T. "Ted" Mora, Jr. agrees to represent the State of Texas as Special Prosecutor in all proceedings in all of the Justice of the Peace Courts in Galveston County, Texas, on an as-needed basis, including the preparation of all necessary forms/documents, approval of peace bonds, and prosecution of court and jury trials.
- 5. This agreement is based on an average of, but not limited to, a minimum of twenty hours work per week.
- 6. Travel/transportation costs incurred by J.T. "Ted" Mora, Jr. necessary to perform these services are not reimbursed by the County.
- 7. Equipment costs (such as computer, telephone, and fax machine) are not reimbursed by the County.
- 8. In consideration for the services stated above, J.T. "Ted" Mora, Jr. will be paid \$1,538.46 bi-weekly by Galveston County.
- 9. In the event J.T. "Ted" Mora, Jr. is temporarily prevented by illness or emergency from performing his duties outlined above, the Office of the Criminal District Attorney will represent the State of Texas in the proceedings. It is the responsibility of J.T. "Ted" Mora, Jr. to contact the Office of the Criminal District Attorney any time he is prevented from performing his duties to insure that he has an agreement for a substitute prosecutor to act in his absence.
- 10. In the event J.T. "Ted" Mora, Jr. is prevented by illness or emergency from performing his duties outlined above for any extended period of time, the Office of the Criminal District Attorney will withhold payment to J.T. "Ted" Mora, Jr. for such period.
- 11. J.T. "Ted" Mora, Jr. will abide by all policies and procedures set out by the Galveston County Criminal District Attorney's Office and Criminal District Attorney Jack Roady.
