



MEMORANDUM

Background:

The Galveston County Sheriff's Office submitted and received approval for a Grant Adjustment Request under the FY 2026 Operation Lone Star Grant Program. The adjustment modifies the originally approved maritime vessel purchase and reallocates associated funds within the approved grant budget while maintaining the overall grant award amount of \$446,425.

Justification:

The Sheriff's Office determined that replacing one Fluid Patrol 29 Maritime Law Enforcement Vessel with two Dargel 250 KAT HDX patrol vessels would better support maritime law enforcement operations in Galveston County's shallow-water and inland waterway environments. The two-vessel configuration provides increased maneuverability, expanded patrol coverage, greater



deployment flexibility, improved response capabilities, and enhanced officer safety while continuing to support the objectives of Operation Lone Star.

The adjustment replaces the originally proposed purchase of one Fluid Patrol 29 Maritime Law Enforcement Vessel with two Dargel 250 KAT HDX Patrol Vessels. The revised vessel configuration increases the vessel acquisition cost by \$19,687.80. To maintain the overall grant award amount of \$446,425 and avoid any additional local funding requirement, \$18,000 was reallocated from the Make Ready Law Enforcement Equipment Package and \$1,687.80 was reallocated from the OLS Vehicle Maintenance budget category. As a result, the overall grant award remains unchanged and no County matching funds are required.

Recommendation:

Grants Administration recommends acknowledgment of the approved project adjustment. The adjustment does not increase the total grant award amount and provides enhanced operational capabilities for maritime law enforcement activities under the Operation Lone Star Grant Program.

Description of Grant Adjustment:

Remove the Fluid Patrol 29 Maritime Law Enforcement Vessel (\$242,312.20), add 2 Dargel 250 KAT HDX patrol vessels (\$262,000). The request to transition from one Fluid Patrol 29 Maritime Law Enforcement Vessel to two Dargel 250 KAT HDX patrol vessels better aligns resources with operational needs in Galveston County's shallow and inland waterways. The Dargel vessels provide increased maneuverability, expanded coverage, and greater deployment flexibility for interdiction and patrol operations. This adjustment enhances mission effectiveness, improves response times, and increases officer safety while maintaining the overall intent of Operation Lone Star to disrupt criminal activity and strengthen maritime enforcement. The difference between the boat purchase would create a \$19,687.80 shortfall. \$18,000 will be removed Make Ready Law Enforcement Equipment and \$1,687.80 will be removed from OLS Vehicle Maintenance to compensate.
