The services requested from this solicitation effort are governed by the provisions stated in GOVERNMENT CODE, CHAPTER 2254, PROFESSIONAL AND CONSULTING SERVICES, SUBCHAPTER A, PROFESSIONAL SERVICES, Sec. 2254.001, also known as the Professional Services Procurement Act. Galveston County will select a provider of professional services or a group or association of providers or award a contract for the services based on the following:

- (1) on the basis of demonstrated competence and qualifications to perform the services; and
- (2) for a fair and reasonable price.
- (b) The professional fees under the contract may not exceed any maximum provided by law.

A. PURPOSE

Galveston County issues this Request for Qualifications solicitation to seek professional engineering and surveying services for the High Island Waterline Improvement Project on the Bolivar Peninsula in Galveston County.

Galveston County is applying to the Texas Department of Agriculture to fund the project under the Community Development Block Grant - Community Development Fund grant program and is seeking to enter into an Engineering and surveying service contract with a state-registered engineer/surveyor. The following outlines this request for qualifications.

B. INTENT STATEMENT

Galveston County intends to award and contract with one engineering firm to complete the scope of work as described above. For this RFQ, Contracts are expected to be executed on August 4th and surveying and application preparation work is to be completed by September 23rd for Galveston County Commissioners Court review and approval to submit before the October 1, 2025 deadline.

Respondent's qualifications will be evaluated, and the most qualified Respondent will be selected, subject to negotiation of fair and reasonable compensation.

The Galveston County Commissioners' Court, and/or authorized designees will be responsible for negotiating with the successful Vendor the scope of work, the standards of performance, the specific technology provided, and the support services required for the proposed projects. All contractual amendments will be processed in accordance with Galveston County Purchasing Policies. Amendments will also be brought to Galveston County Commissioners Court for approval as deemed necessary. commence work under this Agreement until Contractor has obtained all insurance required herein, provided written proof as required herein, and received written notice to proceed issued from the County Purchasing Agent. Failure to provide such evidence of insurance within the ten (10) calendar day period shall constitute an event of default.

Workers' Compensation Insurance. Respondent shall carry in full force Workers' Compensation Insurance Policies, if there is more than one employee, for all its employees, including but not limited to full time, part time, and emergency employees employed by the Contractor.

Commercial General Liability. Respondent shall carry in full force commercial general liability insurance with a limit of not less than \$1,000,000 each occurrence and \$2,000,000 in the aggregate. Subrogation Waiver. Contractor and Contractor's insurance carrier shall waive any and all rights to subrogation against Galveston County in regard to any suit or claim arising out of personal injury or property damage resulting from Contractor's performance under the agreement.

N. TYPE OF CONTRACT

It is the intent of this solicitation to enter into a contract that meets State and County guidelines. The County will provide the resultant contract. A proposed contract does not need to be submitted.

The resultant contract consists of the following documents: Request for Qualification, General Provisions, Special Provisions, General Terms and Conditions (including specifications, drawings, and addenda), Responder's response, Proposal Sheets, contract award, and any other documents referenced herein or attached hereto for the work. Collectively these documents may also be referred to as the Plans and Specifications.

The initial term of the contract shall be one (1) year or until conclusion of the project, unless specified differently within the resultant contract.
