

RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION OF THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF GALVESTON COUNTY, TEXAS AUTHORIZING COUNTY REPRESENTATIVES IN MATTERS PERTAINING TO THE COUNTY'S PARTICIPATION IN THE TEXAS COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court of Galveston County desires to develop a viable community, including decent housing and a suitable living environment, and expanding economic opportunities, principally for persons of low-to-moderate income; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary and in the best interests of the County to participate in the Texas Community Development Block Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court of Galveston County is committed to compliance with federal, state, and program rules, including the current TxCDBG Project Implementation Manual; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF GALVESTON COUNTY, TEXAS:

That the Commissioners Court directs and designates the following to act in all matters in connection with any grant application and the County's participation in the Texas Community Development Block Grant Program:

- The County Judge and the Director of Grant Administration shall serve as the County's Chief Executive Officers and Authorized Representatives to execute a grant application and any subsequent contractual documents, to certify environmental review documents between the Texas Department of Agriculture and the County, and to certify the Payment Request form and/or other forms required for requesting funds to reimburse project costs, and to be assigned the role of Authorized Official in the TDA-GO grant management system.
- In addition to the above designated officials, should any grant be funded the County Auditor and Assistant County Auditor are authorized to certify the Payment Request form and/or other forms required for requesting funds to reimburse project costs, to prepare and submit other financial documentation, and to be assigned the role of Project Director or Payment Processor in the TDA-GO grant management system.
