Whereas there are 13 organized **4-H clubs** within Galveston County with 315 youth participating in the **4-H Program**, led by 62 volunteers in Galveston County; and

Whereas outreach efforts of the **4-H Program** in the past year reached 3,272 youth through twenty-one special interest groups and curriculum enrichment supported by 400 adult volunteers in Galveston County; and

Whereas the **4-H Program** is sponsored in Texas by **Texas AgriLife Extension** of the **Texas A&M University System** and is open to all youths between the ages of eight (8) and eighteen (18) years of age, regardless of socioeconomic level, race, sex, religion, disability, or creed; and

Whereas the **4-H Program** is also an adult educational program with over 50,000 adult volunteers who make a positive contribution to the community, be it urban, rural, or a mixture thereof, through community service and citizenship activity; and

Whereas support of the **4-H Program** is an investment in the education and development of millions of boys and girls who are our nation's most precious resource; and

Whereas the **Commissioners' Court of Galveston County, Texas**, enthusiastically endorses and supports the **Galveston County 4-H Program**; and

Whereas, the week of **October 5 - 11, 2025**, has been designated as **National 4-H Week**; and

Whereas it is the desire of the **Commissioners' Court of Galveston County, Texas**, to pay tribute to this worthwhile organization.

Now, Therefore Be It Resolved that the **Commissioners' Court of Galveston County, Texas**, takes great pride in designating the week of **October 5 - 11, 2025**, as **4-H Week** in Galveston County.

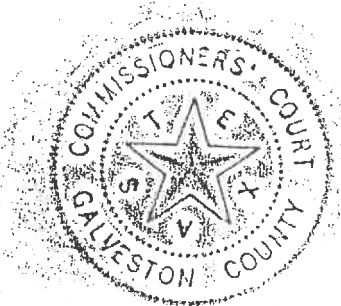
Upon Motion Duly Made and Seconded, the above Resolution was unanimously passed on this, the 13th day of October 2025.

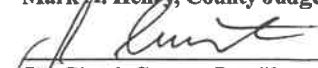
