

## **COUNTY OF GALVESTON**

On this the 15<sup>th</sup> day of September, 2025, the **Commissioners Court of Galveston County, Texas** convened in a **Special Meeting** with the following members thereof present:

when the following proceedings, among others, were had, to-wit:

Whereas, Galveston was acknowledged as the finest natural harbor along the Texas coast; thereby playing a pivotal role in the economic, cultural, and social development of Texas and Galveston County throughout the 19th century; and

Whereas, the Republic of Texas officially designated Galveston as the Navy's operational base by establishing a Navy Yard, building repair facilities, warehouses, a hospital, and administrative offices; and

Whereas, the formal organization of Galveston County in 1839 occurred simultaneously with the organization of the expanded Texas Navy under the Republic; and

Whereas, for nearly a decade the presence at Galveston of the Texas Navy, with its officers and crews, played a prominent role in the creation and development of Galveston County in the late 1830s and early 1840s; and

Whereas, the Texas Navy was viewed by Galveston County citizens as their first line of defense against feared invasion throughout the tenure of the Republic of Texas; and

Whereas, many former members of the Texas Navy later settled in Galveston County and became some of its leading citizens in the years after the Texas Revolution; and

Whereas, Galveston County extends congratulations to the Texas Navy Association and recognizes the significance of Texian Navy Day in remembering the role that the historic Texas Navy played in time of crisis in the early history of our County and State

Now, Therefore Be It Resolved that the Commissioners Court of Galveston County, Texas, hereby proclaims September 20, 2025 as Texian Navy Day in Galveston County, Texas.

Be it Further Resolved that a copy of this Resolution is spread upon the minutes of this Court and the Original hereof be furnished to the Texas Navy.

Upon Motion Duly Made and Seconded, the above Resolution was passed on the 15th day of September, 2025.
