

On this, the 8th day of June 2026, the Commissioners' Court of Galveston County, Texas, convened in a regularly scheduled meeting with the following members thereof present:

when the following proceedings, among others, were had, to wit:

A Resolution of the Commissioners Court of Galveston County, Texas, affirming that the County has not and will not reduce the amount of County funds provided to the Sheriff's Office because of grant funds received under Senate Bill 8

Whereas the State of Texas, through Senate Bill 8 ("SB 8"), has made grant funds available to support law enforcement operations and enhance public safety; and

Whereas the SB 8 grant application requires certification from the County Commissioners Court that the County has not reduced, and will not reduce, the amount of County funds appropriated to the Sheriff's Office because of grant funds provided under SB 8; and

Whereas the Commissioners' Court finds it necessary and appropriate to formally affirm this requirement as part of the County's grant application and compliance obligations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Commissioners' Court of Galveston County, Texas, hereby certifies and affirms that the County has not reduced the amount of County funds provided to the Galveston County Sheriff's Office because of grant funds provided under SB 8, and that the County will not reduce the amount of County funds provided to the Galveston County Sheriff's Office because of grant funds provided under SB 8. The County intends for SB 8 grant funds to supplement, and not supplant, County funding for the Sheriff's Office.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County Judge is authorized to execute any certifications or documents required to complete the SB 8 grant application consistent with this Resolution.
