A. PURPOSE

The County of Galveston is seeking a vendor to supply Precoat Topping Rock to various locations within Galveston County in accordance with the specifications within this Invitation to Bid. All proposed materials must be commercial top-of-the-line grade and quality, and able to withstand use in commercial and or industrial applications.

**B. DEFINITIONS (As mentioned in FAR Subpart 52.2 – Text of Provisions and Clauses)

The Galveston County Commissioners' Court, and/or authorized designees will be responsible for negotiating with the successful Vendor the scope of work, the standards of performance, the specific technology provided, and the support services required for the proposed projects. All contractual amendments will be processed in accordance with Galveston County Purchasing Policies. Amendments will also be brought to Galveston County Commissioners Court for approval as deemed necessary. The approval process serves to ensure the project technology and/or service is within the scope of the resultant contract, that pricing meets the agreed-upon pricing methodology as specified in the contract, and that funds are available.

K. REQUIREMENTS OF INVITATION TO BID

Bidder shall provide one (1) unbound single-sided original and two (2) single-sided hard copies of its response, to the Purchasing Agent on or before the submission deadline specified herein. Font size no smaller than font size 11. Except that organizational charts, other graphics, and footers may be as small as font size 9.

Bidders shall clearly indicate which project or projects are being submitted for consideration in their cover letter.

L. INSURANCE

Bidder must submit, with its response, a current certificate of insurance evidencing coverage in the amounts specified below or greater. In lieu of submitting a certificate of insurance, Bidders may submit a notarized statement from an insurance company authorized to conduct business in the State of Texas guaranteeing that Bidder has such insurance. Provided however, that successful Bidder(s) shall be required to provide a current certificate of insurance to the Galveston County Purchasing Agent's Office before Bidder commences any work hereunder. **Insurance shall be placed with insurers having an A.M. Best's rating of no less than A.** Such insurance must be issued by a casualty company authorized to do business in the State of Texas and in standard form approved by the Board of Insurance Commissioners of the State of Texas, with coverage provisions ensuring the public from loss or damage that may arise to any person or property by reason of services rendered by Contractor.

Galveston County shall be listed as an additional insured on each policy and all certificates of insurance and Contractor shall provide Galveston County with no less than thirty (30) calendar days prior notice of any changes to the policy during the contractual period.

Certificates of Insurance, fully executed by a licensed representative of the insurance company written or countersigned by an authorized Texas state agency, shall be filed with the County Purchasing Agent within ten (10) calendar days of the execution of this Agreement as written proof of such insurance and further provided that Contractor shall not commence work under this Agreement until Contractor has obtained all insurance required herein, provided written proof as required herein, and received written notice to proceed issued from the County Purchasing Agent. **Failure to provide such evidence of insurance within the ten (10) calendar day period shall constitute an event of default.**

Workers' Compensation Insurance. Bidder shall carry in full force Workers' Compensation Insurance Policy(ies), if there is more than one employee, for all its employees, including but not limited to full time, part time, and emergency employees employed by the Contractor.

Commercial General Liability. Bidder shall carry in full force commercial general liability insurance with a limit of not less than \$1,000,000 each occurrence and \$2,000,000 in the aggregate. The Policy shall, minimally, cover liability for bodily injury, personal injury, and property damage.

Business Automobile Liability. Bidder shall carry in full force business automobile liability coverage with a combined bodily injury/property damage limit of not less than \$1,000,000 each accident. The policy shall cover liability arising from the operation of licensed vehicles by policyholder.

Subrogation Waiver. Contractor and Contractor's insurance carrier shall waive any and all rights to subrogation against Galveston County in regard to any suit or claim arising out of personal injury or property damage resulting from Contractor's performance under this Agreement.

M. MATERIAL DESCRIPTION

Furnish aggregate for surface treatments in conformance to the type, grade, and surface aggregate classification.

ANY REFERENCES TO NAME BRANDS ARE FOR BIDDING PURPOSES ONLY AND ARE MEANT TO BE DESCRIPTIVE AND NOT RESTRICTIVE.

N. AGGREGATE

Stockpile aggregates for each source and type separately. Do not add materials to approve stockpiles without the approval of the Road Administrator.

O. AGGREGATE TYPE

To meet TXDOT item 302 "Aggregates for Surface Treatment" specifically PBGR-4 – Precoated crushed gravel, crushed slag, crushed stone, or LRA.

When tested in accordance with Tex-200-F, Part 1, the aggregate gradation must meet the requirements for the specific grade.

Furnished aggregates that meet the quality requirements shown in Exhibit 2. Provide aggregates from sources listed in the Departments BITUMINOUS RATED SOURCE QUALITY CATALOG (BRSQC). If a source is not listed in the catalog or its listed ratings do not meet requirements material from that source may be used only when tested by the Road Administrator and approved before use. Allow 30 calendar days for testing of material from such sources.

Provide aggregates for final surfaces that meet the SAC shown. Do not blend to meet the SAC. Unless otherwise shown, the SAC requirements will apply only to the aggregate used on the travel lanes. The BRSQC lists the SAC for sources on the Aggregate Quality Monitoring Program (AQMP).

P. PRECOATING

Precoat aggregate uniformly and adequately with asphalt material to the satisfaction of the Road Administrator. When specified, specific aggregates may be prohibited from being precoat. Do not precoat LRA aggregate that contains visual surface moisture or excessive quantities of fines. Meet all requirements before precoating. Furnish precoat aggregate that spreads uniformly using approved mechanical spreading equipment.

The Road Administrator retains the right to select a target value for the desired percent by weight of residual bitumen coating on the aggregate. Furnish precoat aggregate that is within + or -03% of the target value when tested in accordance with Tex-236-F. The Road Administrator may require trial batches to assist in selecting the target value.

The Road Administrator retains the right to remove precoat material from aggregate samples in accordance with Tex-210-F and test the aggregate to verify compliance with all requirements. Gradation testing may be performed with precoat intact.

Q. ASPHALT MATERIALS

Precoat the aggregates with asphalt material that meets the requirements of item 300, "Asphalt, Oils and Emulsions." Precoat the LRA and flux oil meeting the requirements of Item 300. "Limestone rock Asphalt Pavement." Unless a specific precoat material is specified on the plans, use any asphalt material that meets the requirement of Item 300

R. ADDITIVES

When specified, use the type and rate of additive specified in accordance with Item 301, "Asphalt Antistripping Agents." Tex-530-C will be used for verification during production testing, unless otherwise directed.

S. CONSTRUCTION

Deliver aggregate to the locations specified. Prevent segregation, mixing of the various materials or sizes, and contamination with foreign materials when aggregates are stockpiled. The Road Administrator will reject contaminated stockpiles.

Providing adequate initial cooling of precoat aggregate to prevent asphalt or aggregate damage due to excessive heat buildup in stockpiles. When asphalt cement is the precoating material, limit stockpile height to 3 ft. immediately after production. Consolidate stockpile after adequate cooling, as approved. The Road Administrator will reject stockpiles showing evidence of damage due to excessive heat buildup

T. EQUIPMENT

Manufacture precoat aggregate in a mixing plant that produces uniformly coated aggregate.

Galveston County reserves the right to order more or less of this product.

U. POINTS OF DELIVERY

All materials are to be delivered F.O.B. points of destination unless otherwise specified by ordering personnel. The Precoat Topping Rock is to be furnished and delivered to specific job sites as designated by the County. Delivery shall be made at the time the material is needed for road construction. When specified by the County, delivery shall be made at certain designed County job sites as indicated below:

V. PRODUCT AVAILABILITY AND TIME OF DELIVERY

Time of delivery and product availability are of the essence in all Galveston County supply contracts. The contracted vendor shall be required to have the stated quantities available and delivered at the requested locations at all times throughout the contractual period(s). In the event that the County has to procure the requested products or materials from another supply source due to the inability of the contracted vendor to maintain the requested quantities, the County reserves the right to procure the materials from another supply source at no penalty to the County. Furthermore, these incidents shall not constitute a breach of contract. The County reserves the right to cancel any orders, or part thereof, without obligation or penalty if delivery is not made in accordance with the schedule specified by the Bidder and accepted by the County.

W. AWARDED PRICES

Any unit prices submitted by the Bidder shall include all costs to the County, including the material, delivery, current freight rate, state tax, or any other cost.

Award prices include all royalties and costs arising from patents, trademarks, and copyrights in any way involved in the work. Whenever the Awardee is required or desires to use any design, device, material or process covered by letters of patent or copyright, the Awardee shall indemnify and save harmless the County, its officers, agents and employees from any and all claims for infringement by reason of the use of any such patented design, tool, material, equipment, or process, to be performed under the contract, and shall indemnify the County its officers, agents, and employees for any costs, expenses and damages which may be incurred by reason of any infringement at any time during the prosecution or after the completion of the work.

X. COST

The unit price per ton submitted by the bidder shall include all costs to the County, including the material, delivery, current freight rate, state tax, or any other cost. Measurement and payments shall be per ton delivery to jobsite or to designated County stockyards based on truck scale weights with State certified scales.
